What is the World Wide Web?

Created in 1992

Developed by CERN (European Council for Nuclear Research)

Global connection of hyperlinked pages

HTML – language used to write Web pages

HTTP – protocol for transmission of Web pages

Web browser – software that received information over the Internet, interprets the HTML and displays the results

Hypertext – text that is linked to other information
